THE IDEA AND PURPOSE OF THE CONFERENCE

The aim of this year 's conference is to assess the impact of selected demographic processes (population aging in economically developed countries, but also labor-related migration in some countries, including Poland) on the functioning of the pension system, health care and family policy - now and in the foreseeable future of the next 20-30 years.

Moreover, the discussion will include financial and regulatory aspects of social security systems, the interrelationship of social security systems (such as the impact of extending the retirement age on the additional burden of the health care system) and their relationship with the labor market (e.g. under-insurance of entrepreneurs running their own businesses and its consequences).

The conference will be conducted in both Polish and English.

Framework of the conference

2. Migration processes and the pension system.
3. The design of the pension system in Poland and in other countries.
4. Pension system models.
5. Prospects for changes in pension systems.
6. Opportunities and threats for pension systems.

8. Legal and organizational aspects of social security.
9. Institutional, demographic and socio-cultural aspects of pension reforms.
10. Politics and the effectiveness of investment of pension funds and other institutions of the pension sector.
11. Social responsibility of pension sector institutions.
12. Contributions and benefits in the pension system.
13. Individual retirement accounts and pension schemes for employees.
14. The impact of demographic change on the health care system.
15. The impact of the extension of the statutory retirement age on financing health care systems.
16. The organization and funding of long-term care for the elderly.
17. Socio-economic aspects of the retirement age extension.
18. The human capital of older people.
19. Comparison of the situation of young and older people in the labor market.
20. Elderly people 's entrepreneurship.
21. Development of silver economy in Poland.
22. Mental and economic security of older people.
23. Social perception of old age.
24. Trust in the relationships between elderly people and society.
