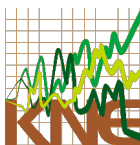

# THE IDEA AND PURPOSE OF THE CONFERENCE

**The purpose** of the conference is to assess the impact of selected demographic, economic and technical processes on functioning of social security systems (especially: pension schemes, healthcare systems and long-term care systems for the elderly) in different countries.

The conference will provide an opportunity to compare economic and legal-institutional solutions used in various countries (including the provisional effects of social security reforms introduced in the late twentieth century and in the first decades of the twenty-first century) in response to the challenges of demography, structural transformations on the labor market, globalization, as well as socio-cultural transformations and technical changes affecting the formation of living and working conditions of people of working and post-production age.

**The conference is interdisciplinary** and it is addressed to the representatives of social sciences as well as humanities, and engineering.
